Submission Guidelines

The NKBA Renovation Angel Luxury Kitchen Recycling Awards seek to recognize professionals like you who've successfully recycled one or more luxury kitchen projects.

will be given for**



Achievements in Luxury Recycling

1. Highest Valued Kitchen Donated.
2. Most Desirable Luxury Kitchen.
3. Largest Volume of Kitchens Upcycled from a Firm.



Achievements in Repurposed Kitchen Design

1. Small kitchen project (Up to 250 Sq. Ft.)
2. Medium kitchen project (251-750 Sq. Ft.)
3. Large kitchen project (751 Sq. Ft. and Up)

“Angel” Discretionary Award: This is an industry award to recognize a Manufacturer, Designer, Design or Architectural Firm, or showroom whose efforts to be sustainable are remarkable. Remarkable to us means going above and beyond normal efforts to recycle whether through purchases of recycled kitchens, or through scope of recycled projects.

Entry Requirements

- Contest entries must be submitted online at www.RenovationAngel.com.
- Kitchen projects that were recycled or donated between January 1, 2018 – November 20, 2020.

All entries must be received by 11:59PM PST Friday, November 20, 2020.

- Entries are open to Kitchen Designers, Architects, Interior Designers, Builders, Showrooms, Distributors, Manufacturers and Industry Professionals.

- Enter all required information, and please be sure to include any co-designers or collaborators.

Don't forget your photos! 2-3 High Res color photos (300dpi).

- A 250-500 word design statement about your entry.

Specific Criteria

- Luxury Kitchens only; Defined as a project where one or more of the following brands were included. (See list).
- Projects should be as complete as possible and include upcycled cabinets, countertops, sink(s), faucet(s), and appliances.
- Kitchens must be recycled in one of the following ways; (a) as a donation to a non-profit organization, or, (b) kitchen was resold and/or (c) was retrofitted into another space.
- No fee to enter competition.
- All identifying design, client and firm information should be omitted, removed, or blacked out from photographs, floor plans, elevations and design statements.

Judges will consider the following criteria when reviewing each selection:

- 1) Percentage of recycled products in project
- 2) Creativity & Design Planning
- 3) Quality of Design Statement

Winner Recognition

- Winners announced at awards ceremony at KBIS in Orlando, Florida February 2021.
- Featured across NKBA and RA Social Media platforms
- Included in a national press release to consumer and trade media.



FAQs

1. How do you define Luxury Kitchens?

A luxury kitchen is one where at least 3 or more of the defined luxury brands are present. Please see Luxury Brands list on Renovation Angel's website: www.renovationangel.com.

2. How do you define recycled?

Recycled is defined as a project where 50% or more of the materials used were recycled.

3. What is an appraisal report?

This is a valuation of personal or real property conducted by a USPAP (Uniform Standards of Professional Appraisal Practice) certified appraiser.

4. What if my project doesn't quite fit a specific category?

If it is a recycled kitchen, we'd love to see it! Send it in- it may be eligible in one or multiple categories.

5. What is the deadline for entries?

All entries must be submitted by 11:59PM PST Friday, November 20, 2020.

6. What do I need to have a complete entry?

To qualify, please submit your design statement, the name, date, and location of the project, list of the brands used, and 2-3 high resolution (300dpi) photos. Projects MUST have been completed between January 1, 2018 – November 20, 2020. If you are entering a project for the most valuable donated kitchen, please include the appraisal value report (must be from a USPAP certified appraiser).

7. What does my design statement need to have?

Tell us about the design inspiration for the project. How did you become interested in recycling? What were the homeowners wishes? What was the background of the original kitchen?

8. I am a consumer/homeowner, can I enter?

No, this contest is for Industry Professionals only.

9. Can I enter more than one project?

Yes, as long as it was completed between January 1, 2018 – November 20, 2020.
